

## AGTA and WJA Partner Again for the AGTA Spectrum Awards™

Gem Diva Awards™ to Benefit WJA's Cindy Edelstein Memorial Fund

The fund, which will be part of the WJA Foundation, will be earmarked for educational opportunities within the jewelry design and education communities.
